TENDER NOTICE

1. Sealed tenders in prescribed format are invited from the experienced reputed agencies for construction of black topped road connecting NH-23 and General Office of the BSL Company.

2. General Description of Scope of Work:

Construction of black topped road of MORTH specifications stipulated in different tables and clauses and as per tender schedule

3.Tender Submission: Non transferable tender documents can be obtained from the office of the Dy.Manager (finance),B.S.L.CO.LTD, Birmitrapur during office hours on any working day from 07/02/2011 to 23/2/2011 on payment of Rs 520 (Five hundred twenty only) only per unit which is inclusive of VAT @ 4%.The tender document can also be down loaded from our website www.birdgroup.gov.in & NIC Portal and the cost of tender document shall be paid by demand draft of Rs 520/- drawn in favour of "The B.S.L.Co.Ltd" payable at Birmitrapur/Rourkela alongwith the techno commercial bid.

In case of downloaded tender, the bidder has to submit an undertaking on the company's letter head that no amendment have been made in the tender document downloaded from company's website, at the time of submission of the tender document. In case of non submission of cost of tender document, the tender shall be liable for rejection.

3.1.Tenders in the prescribed format complete in all respects accompanied with earnest money of Rs. 30,000.00 (Rupees Thirty thousand only)in the form of Bank draft/Pay order drawn on any Nationalised Bank in favour of "THE BISRA STONE LIME CO. LTD." Payable at Birmitrapur should reach or dropped in the tender box of the office of the Business Head.

3.2. The Tender document shall be submitted in two parts i.e Part-I Techno Commercial Bid and Part-II Price Bid in separate sealed envelopes. Both Techno-commercial bid and price bid shall be sealed in separate envelopes with complete tender details superscribed on both the envelopes and clearly identifying the techno-commercial bid and price-bid on the respective envelopes. Both the bid shall be kept in another sealed envelope superscribing the Tender Notice No. and date.

4. Techno-commercial bid: The Part-I, Techno Commercial Bid shall be opened in the presence of the bidders or their accredited representative at 3:30 P.M on 24/2/2011 in the Office of the Business Head, The Bisra Stone Lime Company Ltd. Birmitrapur, Sundergarh(Orissa)

5.Price bid: Part –II i.e. Price Bid of the tenderers, whose Techno Commercial bid are found acceptable, shall be opened on a fixed date & time, which will be intimated to the bidders separately after opening and finalisation of technical bids. In this respect, the decision of the company shall be final and binding on the tenderers.

Note : - (Bids received after 3 P.M. but before opening at 3.30 P.M. can be accepted & opened, but bids received after 3.30 P.M. will be rejected.)

6. Pre-bid consultation:

The tenderers are free to join pre bid consultation to be held on 17/2/2011 at 04.00P.M in the office of the Business Head for clarifying doubt / seeking explanations in regard to provision of the tender. The tender document may be amended suitably if any genuine doubts or explanation sought are needed solely at the discretion of BSLC.

7.The company shall not be liable for any delay in submission of the tender documents due to postal delay and no extension of date for tender submission / tender opening shall be given for this reason.

8. The company reserves the right not to accept the lowest offer. The company also reserves the right to cancel the tender and in such an event no claim of any tenderer for such a decision by the company shall be entertained.

9. The validity of the offer shall be for 120 days from the date of opening of the techno-commercial bid.

10. Interested Parties are advised to visit with Manager (Project)/Manager (Mines) the site and familiarise themselves with the site conditions, concerned areas and go through the attached terms & condition of the tender document before submission of tender documents.

11. Bidders are required to give an undertaking that they will abide by all the terms & conditions of the tender document as per format given in annexure - I.

12. The expected date of commencement of work will be within 10 days from the date of issue of L.O.I/Agreement.

CHAPTER-II

1. SCOPE OF WORK

Scope of Work: It includes the following:

- 1.1 **Excavation or filling** as required for roadway in soil using manual means including loading in truck for carrying of cut earth to embankment site with all lifts & lead upto 1000 metres and watering, compaction with compactor/roller at OMC as per drawing & clause 301 of MORT & H specification for road and bridge works (4th Revision) and as per clause 305.3.4 of MORT&H specification for road & Bridge works (4th Revision). 2.5% camber is to be provided in sub grade.
- 1.2 **Filling sand** with Coarse Graded Material as per drawing and clause 401.4 of MORT & H specification for road and bridge works. (4th revision)
- 1.3. **By Mix in Place Method (GSB):**Construction of granular sub-base by providing close graded material, spreading in uniform layers with motor grader on prepared surface, mixing by mix in place method with rotavator at OMC, & compacting with vibratory roller to achieve the desired density complete as per clause 401 of MORT & H (4th Revision) and direction of engineer-in- charge
- 1.4. **Wet Mix Macadam:** Providing, laying, spreading & compacting graded stone aggregate to wet mix macadam specification including premixing the material with water at OMC in mechanical mix plant carriage of mixed Material by tipper to site laying in uniform layers with paver in sub – base/base course on well prepared surface & compacting with vibratory roller to achieve the desired density as per clause 406, 501 and section of specification for road & bridge work of MORT&H (4th Revision) and direction of engineer-in-charge
- 1.5. **Prime coat:** Providing & applying primer coat with bitumen emulsion on prepared surface of granular base including clearing of road surface & spraying primer at the rate of 0.60 kg/sqm using mechanical means. As per the clause 502 of MORT & H specification for road & bridge work (4th Revision) & direction of the engineer-in-charge
- 1.6. **Surface Dressing/carpeting :** Providing & laying surface dressing as wearing course in single coat(15mm thick) using crushed stone aggregates of specified size on a layer of bituminous binder laid on prepared surface & rolling with 8 – 10 tonne smooth wheeled steel roller as per clause 510 of MORT & H specification for road & bridge works (4th Revision)
- 1.7. **Tack Coat:** Providing & applying tack coat with bitumen emulsion using emulsion pressure distributor at the rate of 0.20 kg per sqm on the prepared bituminous/granular surface cleaned with mechanical broom as per clause 503.1 to 503.6 & section 900 of MORT & H specification for road & bridge works (4th Revision) & direction of the engineer-in-charge.
- 1.8. **Bituminous Macadam:** Providing & laying bituminous macadam with 100 – 120 TPH hot mix plant producing an average output of 75 tonnes per hour using crushed aggregates of specified grading premixed with bituminous binder, transported to site laid over a previously prepared surface with paver finisher to the required grade, level & alignment & rolled to achieve the desired

compaction as per clause 504 of MORT & H specification for road and bridge works (4th Revision)

1.9. Semi dense bituminous concrete:

Providing & laying semi dense bituminous concrete with 100 – 120 TPH batch type HMP producing an average output of 75 tonnes per hour using crushed aggregates of specified grading, premixed with bituminous binder @ 4.5 to 5 percent of mix & filler, transporting the hot mix to work site, laying with a hydrostatic paver finisher with sensor control to the required grade level & alignment, rolling with smooth wheeled, vibratory & tandem rollers to achieve the desired compaction as per clause 508 of MORT & H specification for road and bridge works (4th Revision).

1.10. Construction of sub – grade & earthen shoulders with approved material obtained from borrow pits with all lifts & leads, transporting to site, spreading, grading to required stop & compacted to meet requirement of table No. 300-2 of MORT & H specification for road & bridge works (4th Revision)

2. GUARANTEE:-

Guarantee shall be for a period of minimum one year from the date of issue final acceptance/commissioning certificate of the road. Successful tenderer will have to maintain the road for one year from the date of commissioning. If any defect is detected by the concern authority, the contractors shall make rectification of such defects during the maintenance period of twelve months from the date of completion of work. All such work shall be carried out by the contractors at his own expenses. If the contractor shall fail to do any such work, the BSLC Ltd shall be entitled to carry out such work by own workmen or by other contractors and the cost thereof deducted from contractor security deposit.

3. CONTRACT PERIOD :

For 6 Months from the date of awarding the job. No extension of time period shall be entertained without sufficient justification to the satisfaction of the management (BSLC) that the delay is beyond the control of the agency/tenderer.

4. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:

Each Tenderer must be accompanied with the non interest bearing pre-bid Earnest Money Deposit (as prescribed) of Rs 30,000.00 (Rupees thirty thousand only) in shape of Bank draft/Pay order drawn on any Schedule/Nationalised Bank in favour of "The Bisra Stone Lime Company Limited." payable at Birmitrapur/Rourkela. Name of the remitter shall be mentioned in the DD/PO. Tender without prescribed earnest money shall be rejected. The earnest money of the successful bidder shall be converted into security deposit which bears no interest.

Note: - Earnest money of the unsuccessful bidder will be refunded after award of the contract.

5. INSTRUCTION TO TENDERERS:

- 5.1 Tender must be submitted in sealed envelope marking the name of work as mentioned in the tender notice and addressed to The Bisra stone Lime Company Limited At/P.O-Birmitrapur, Dist-Sundergarh, Orissa, PIN-770033 on or before the time mentioned in the tender notice. The Tenders will be opened soon after on the same day and rates read out in presence of the Tenderers or other representatives as are present.
- 5.2 Tenders sealed and super scribed as above may also be sent by hand only. A tender which is received after the time and date specified above, is liable to rejection. Company is not responsible for any loss of Tender or late receipt of tenders.
- 5.3 Any tender delivered or sent otherwise will be at the risk of the Tenderers.
- 5.4 Tender form containing 'over written' or 'erased' rate or rates and amount not shown in figures and words in English will be liable to rejection.
- 5.5 Tender quoting rates on until different from those prescribed in the tender schedules will be liable to rejection. Tenders not received in the prescribed from as specified therein and without earnest money at the time of opening will be summarily rejected.
- 5.6 If a Tenderer seeks to clarify his quotations or rates, this should only be done in a separate covering letter No. material modifications to the specifications, item description, contract clauses etc. will however, be entertained. Other clarifications may be considered. If the contents of the covering letter are to be considered, as part of the quotation, this should be specifically mentioned by the tenderer, it any of these conditions admitted for consideration has a financial bearing on the cost quoted, and the additional cost arising out of this condition will be added for comparative evaluation of tenders.
- 5.7. Any tender containing clerical or arithmetical mistakes may be rejected.
- 5.8. Any request from the Tenderer in respect of additions alterations, modifications, etc of either terms or conditions or rates of his tender after opening of the tender may lead to rejection of his tender. If the Tenderer, with draws his tender after opening of the tender but before the expiry of the validity period of the tender. The earnest money shall be liable to be forfeited.
- 5.9. The successful tenderer shall make his own arrangement for all materials except as specified in the contract (if any)
- 5.10 By submitting a tender for the work a Tender will be deemed to have satisfied himself by actual inspection of the site and locality of the work, that rates quoted by him in the Tender will be adequate to complete such work according to the specifications and condition attached thereto and he has taken into account all condition and difficulties that may be encountered during its process and to have quoted labour and material rates which shall include cost of material with taxes, Outcry ,land other duties, lead, lift, loading and unloading freight for materials

and all other charges necessary for the completion of the work, to the entire satisfaction of the engineer.

5.11 Tenderers must also submit with the Tender copies of testimonials with regard to their experience and satisfy The B.S.L.Co.Ltd.'s authorities on the following points if and when called upon to do so.

(i) His position as an independent contractor or as the properly accredited agent of a responsible firm, in proof of which he must produce the requisite registered Power of Attorney and the expressed authority from the same firm to act as its agent.

(ii) His ability, to supervise his work personally or in the event of ill-health or authorised absence there from to employ a competent and responsible agent who is to be specially named and approved beforehand.

5.12. The following particulars must also accompany the tender.

(a) Details of works of similar type and magnitude carried out by the Tenderer. In the Performa shown in Appendix-I.

(b) Details of constructions Plants and Equipment available with the tenderer, for use in this work in the Performa shown in Appendix-II.

5.13. Acceptance of the Tender will be intimated to the successful Tenderer through a letter of intent. The contractor shall then be required to execute an agreement within the time specified in the letter of intent. In the event of failure on the part of Contractor to sign the agreement within the specified time the amount of earnest money shall be forfeited and the acceptance of his tender shall be considered as withdrawn

5.14. If the Tenderer has a relative employed in any capacity in The B.S.L.Co. Ltd. shall inform the authority calling for tenders of the fact when submitted his tender, failing which his contract may be rescinded, if the fact subsequently comes to light, and he shall be liable to make good to the employer any loss or damage resulting from such cancellation to the like extent provided in the case of cancellation of general condition of contract.

5.15. No contract work, however petty, may be carried out except under and in accordance with a duly executed agreement or a special written authority from a duly authorised office of the employer.

5.16. No agreement is valid unless signed by the contractor or his duly authorised agent and by a competent person on behalf of the employer.

5.17. Canvassing in any form is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the Tenderers, who resort to canvassing, will be liable to rejection.

5.18. The form of agreement, form of Tender, invitation of tender, Instruction to Tenderers, General conditions of contract special conditions of contract specifications, Drawings and the rates and amount quoted against the items of the tender schedule together with letter of intent awarding the works shall form the contract, if there be any difference between the description in the specifications

and drawing and the works items in the tender schedule, the works in the tender schedule shall prevail for determining the rate.

- 5.19. In case of abnormality low quoted rate, the company reserves the right to call justification lowest tenderer. Further the contractor may have to submit an amount fixed by the company before of work in the form of Bank Guarantee/Demand Draft against performance guarantee.

6. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITION:**

In order to qualify in the techno commercial bid of the tender, the tenderer must produce the following documentary evidence with the techno-commercial bid.

- 6.1 In case of down loading, the cost of tender paper of Rs 520/-(Rupees five hundred twenty only) including VAT @ 4% in shape of DD drawn in favour of "The Bisra Stone Lime company Limited" payable at Birmitrapur/Rourkela to be enclosed.
- 6.2 The EMD of Rs 30,000/(Rupees thirty thousand only)- in shape of crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of "The Bisra Stone Lime Company Limited" payable at Birmitrapur/Rourkela to be enclosed.
- 6.3 The agency must have experience of successful completion of at least one project of construction of road of MORTH (Ministry of road transport & highway, Govt of India) Specification to their credit and must produce document in support of their credential.
- Note-Experience in the name of the partners of the firm or that of Directors of the company will be considered as experience of the firm/company participating in the tender.
- 6.4 a) Registered Partnership deed in case of a partnership firm.
b) Memorandum of Article and Article of Association in case of a Joint stock company.
c) Proprietorship certificate duly certified by a notary in a stamp paper in case of proprietorship firm is to be enclosed.
- 6.5 Copy of the Income Tax PAN and copy of income tax return for any one of the last three years i.e 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09 signed by Chartered accountant is to be enclosed.
- 6.6 The agency must have service tax registration Number. Copy of service tax number is to be enclosed.

- 6.7 An under taking, in company /firm's letter head is required regarding that the party has not been debarred/blacklisted by any PSU and BSLC at any point of time.
- 6.8 A declaration to be submitted that the bidder has carefully read all terms and conditions of the tender document and he is fully satisfied and accepted all terms and condition of the tender as per undertaking format attached as per (Annexure – I)
- 6.9 The tenderer before submission must sign each page of the tender schedule. Otherwise the tender will be treated as invalid.

(Note: Submission of any forge document will attract legal action including rejection of tender or cancellation of contract at the risk and cost of the contractor if awarded.)

CHAPTER-III

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. DEFINITIONS:

- a) **Tenderer/Bidder:** Tenderer/Bidder means a person, Society, Firm, or Company willing to participate by accepting terms and conditions given in the tender documents.
- b) **Tender:** Tender means the work to be perform according to the tender documents (both technical and commercial) submitted by the tenderer for consideration of BSLC..
- c) **Name of the Tender:** Name of the Tender means the work to be perform by the tenderer
- d) **Techno-commercial Bid:** Techno-commercial Bid means documents regarding eligibility condition as stipulated in the tender documents for qualifying the bidder for consideration of the Price Bid
- e) **Scheduled Rate:** Scheduled Rate means the rate quoted by the tenderer in the prescribed format for various activities to be performed by the tenderer.
- f) **Price Bid:** Price Bid means the document containing the scheduled rate to be considered for the purpose of evaluation and award of contract.
- g) **Contractor/Consultant/Agency:** Contractor means the person or society, firm, company whose tender has been accepted by the BSLC.
- h) **BSLC:** BSLC means "The Bisra Stone Lime Company Ltd." A company incorporated in India and having its registered office at AG-104,Saurav Abasan Sector-II, Salt Lake City, Kolkata-106.
- i) **Employer :** Employer means BSLC
- j) **Competent Authority:** - Competent Authority means CMD or any designated officer by the CMD.
- k) **Taxes:** Taxes means Income Tax, Surcharge, Service Tax, Cess Tax, value Added Tax, Entry Tax, and any Other Tax, Levy, Fees, Cess imposed by the Government from Time to Time.

2. EARNEST MONEY:

- 2.1. Cheques, Bonds, guarantee bonds and Govt Securities (Stock Certificates, bearer bonds, promissory notes, and cash certificates) will not be accepted towards the earnest money. No interest will be paid on EMD.
- 2.2. Tender without prescribed earnest money shall be rejected.
- 2.3. Earnest money shall be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders after the finalisation of the tender.

3. SECURITY DEPOSIT (SD):

10% of total contract price as prorate to be deducted from every progressive bill towards security deposit. The security deposit will be returned on demand after 12 months from completion of the job in all respect and successful handover of the said work and production of clearance certificate and submission of no claim certificate. The earnest money of successful bidders shall be converted into security deposit and the security deposit shall not bear any interest.

4. SUBMISSION OF TENDER:

The Tender shall be submitted in parts i.e Part-I i.e Techno-Commercial Bid and Part-II i.e Price Bid in separate covers super scribing for which the tender is submitted, name and address of the tenderer. Both the above covers shall be put in another covers super scribing the job for which the tender is submitted alongwith address of the tenderer.

The Tender shall be submitted to the **Business Head The** Bisra Stone Lime Company Limited, at/P.O- Bimitrapur, Sundargarh (Orissa) on or before 3-00 P.M of 24/02/2011.

5. OPENING OF TENDER:

The Technical bid part-I shall be opened on 24/2/2011 at 3.30 P.M in the office of the **Business Head** , The Bisra Stone Lime Company Limited, At/P.O- Bimitrapur, Sundargarh (Orissa) in the presence of the tenderers or their accredited representatives. The date of opening of price bid shall be intimated to the tenderer whose techno-commercial bids found acceptable.

6. PENALTY, WAIVAL & TERMINATION:

If the tenderer has not commenced the work from the date as mentioned in the agreement/work order the EMD/security deposit deposited for the work shall be forfeited. If the work is commenced but not completed then penalty shall be imposed @ Rs 1,000 per day of delay. If the delay is found to be for reasons which are beyond the control of the tenderer the penalty can be waived by the competent authority of BSLC on receipt of request from tenderer and recommendation of mines office. The competent authority if convinced can extend the period of contract for such period as found reasonable and thereafter may terminate the contract. In case of termination of the contract EMD/security deposit shall be forfeited. However, the payment of the bill for the work already completed shall be made to the tenderer by BSLC after due examination and recommendation of Business Head.

7. Expectation from the tenderer:

Tenderers, along with tender, shall submit the following documents duly attested by a Gazetted Officer/Notary Public.

Details and documents regarding financial status of the firm like latest Profit and Loss account, Balance Sheet, Auditor's Report etc. for last three completed years along with Banker's Certificate regarding financial stability to undertake the tendered work. Banker's Certificate should be specific and clearly outlining the limits of overdrafts. Bank Guarantees etc. being enjoyed by the Tenderers.

8. Award of Contract

8.1. The company reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders or distributes the work amongst different tenderers without assigning any reason thereof.

8.2. Award of contract shall be made at the absolute discretion of BSLC. The company reserves the right to reject any part or whole of the tender without assigning any reason whatsoever. For such cancellation the tenderer shall not be entitled to claim any cost, charges, expenses incidental to or incurred by him through or in connection with the preparation and submission without assigning any reason whatsoever.

8.3. BSLC also reserves the right not to accept the lowest offer and to divide the work to more than one party/parties.

8.4. BSLC shall not be liable for any delay in receipt of the tender document by the Tenderers due to postal delay and no extension of time to the date of tender opening shall be given for this reason.

9. Signing of Agreement and execution of work.

9.1 The successful bidder is expected to appear in the office of Business Head to sign the contract agreement within 5 days and start the work within 10 days from the date of issuance of LOI. In case the tenderer is decline to sign the agreement or to take up the work within stipulated time, in such eventuality will have any such claim.

9.2. In case the tenderer declines to take up the work, BSLC reserves the right to terminate the contract and forfeit the earnest money/security deposit of the contractors in such eventually, the tenderer have no claim for the cost he/they might have incurred for taking the work and the cost of the work he/they have done by that time and the work may be rescinded.

10. Obligation of the contractor:

10.1. The contractor shall be solely responsible for deductions and maintenance of record regarding Provident Fund, Pension Scheme, Deposit Link Insurance Fund in respect of contractors/employees employed by him in connection with the work mentioned in the description of work of this contract documents as required under Employees Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 and Rules and Regulations made there under. The contributions to Provident Fund at the prescribed rate alongwith other contributions and charges have to be duly made as provided for in the said Act. The said contributions (both employer's and employees) along with other charges shall be deposited within the prescribed time to the Regional Provident Fund Commissioner. In case the contractor fails to comply with the above, the company reserves the right to arrange for the same and the entire amount shall be recovered from the bills/security deposit of the contractor(s) or otherwise.

10.2. The contractor shall get their establishment registered with the appropriate Regional Provident Fund Commissioner and produce a valid document to Mines Office within one month from the date of award of this work. In the event of their failure to comply with the above, necessary deductions will be made from their running bills to cover the liabilities under the Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions act,1952.

11. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE TENDERER/AGENCY/CONTRACTOR:

11.1. The work order is to be accepted by the tenderer within 3 days of communication of the same.

11.2. The tenderer will commence and complete the work as stipulated in the tender document

11.3. The tenderer is to ask for necessary documents/records from BSLC within 5(five) days of acceptance of the work order for carrying out the work.

11.4. The agency shall have to make his own arrangements for travelling, boarding, lodging etc to the site.

11.5. All the corrections/ compliances on deficiency pointed out by the BSLC during the preparation of the project should be duly complied by the contractor within the stipulated time.

11.6. The liaison required for the purpose should be exclusively done by the contractor/agency.

11.7. All other Expenditure incidental to such processing to be born by the agency including statutory payments.

11.9. The job cannot be sublet in part or in whole without the written consent of the Business Head of BSLC, Birmitrapur.

11.10. Tenderer will comply the direction of Business Head/Manager (Project) or his authorised representative from time to time.

11.11. All security arrangement for the materials to be utilised in the project shall be done by the contractor up to commissioning and handing over the Road.

11.12. Contractor has to submit the work programme and test reports of different items during the construction as per following list:

A.FOR SOIL AND GSB (GRANULAR SUB BASE):

1. Work Programme on daily basis for the next day work to be carried out at site.
2. Progress report of work carried out in one week on weekly basis.
