BSCL wishes to offer 6,00,000 Cubic Metres (approximately) of **Minor Mineral** for immediate **SALE** by Ex-Mines mode from earmarked places i.e. Old Dump; located within 3 km radius of its mining leasehold area on "AS IS WHERE IS BASIS" within the time period of one year from awarding the sale order through open mode of tendering.

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## CHAPTER-II

### GENERAL CONDITIONS

#### 1. SCOPE OF WORK

The material for sale will be done for Minor Minerals from BSLC Mines within the contract period. The buyers shall lift the minor mineral from earmarked places (old dump) of BSLC mines on 'AS IS WHERE IS BASIS'. The mode of dispatch will be "BY ROAD", for which the loading & transportation is to be arranged solely by the successful bidder.

The indicative specifications of the material are as follows:

#### 2. CONTRACT PERIOD:

2.1 The validity of the contract shall be as specified in the tender documents.

#### 3. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:

Each Tender must be accompanied with the non interest bearing pre-bid Earnest Money Deposit (as prescribed) of Rs 1,00,000/- ( Rupees One lakh only). in shape of Bank draft/Pay order drawn on any Schedule/Nationalised Bank in favour of "The Bisra Stone Lime Co. Ltd." payable at Birmitrapur/Rourkela. Name of the remitter shall be mentioned in the DD/PO. Tender without prescribed earnest money shall be rejected.

The earnest money of the successful bidder shall be converted into security deposit which bears no interest.

#### 4. SECURITY DEPOSIT (SD):

4.1. The Pre-Bid EMD of successful bidders (SB) will get automatically converted into Security Deposit.

4.2. The SD will be released on the following terms:

- a) SD will be released after 3 months from the date of completion of the contract.
- b) On production of certificate from Mines Manager, Manager(Security) and Dy Manager(P&A) that he has cleared and performed his statutory obligations/obligations whatsoever under this contract.

5. **PAYMENT FOR LIFTING OF MATERIAL:**

The successful bidders shall be required to deposit non-interest bearing advance payment covering full value of 100% of the material within 10 working days from date of issuance of sale offer.

All payments towards material value, taxes, levies, etc are to be made in the form of DD/PO or any electronic money transfer system approved by RBI in favour of "The Bisra Stone Lime Company Limited" drawn on a Scheduled/nationalised Bank and payable at Birmitrapur/Rourkela. Collection charges, if applicable shall be borne by the successful bidders.

6. **RESERVE PRICE:**

The reserve price of ex-mines sale of minor minerals is Rs 150 per Cu.m. As such, the price offered by the bidder shall not be less than reserve price, failing which, the bidder will be disqualified & the bid will liable to be rejected.

7. **NORMS OF SALE OF MINOR MINERALS:**

- All arrangement for loading and transporting of the material from mines shall be made by the successful bidder at his own cost by mechanicals means.

- The volumetric measurement of minor mineral to be sold shall be taken on general office weigh bridge of BSLC and the same shall be final and basis for payment.

- Full payment will be made in advance before lifting the material by way of demand draft/ pay order/money transfer in favour of "The Bisra Stone Lime Co. Ltd." Payable at Birmitrapur/ Kolkata as would be intimated from time to time. Full payment includes the price of material, royalty, sales Tax, Surcharge, Entry tax and other dues as levied by the Govt. Statutory authority from time to time.

- Material once sold can not be rejected or returned for deviation in size or quality and also for that no refund of material value and/or EMD/SD can be claimed.

- The party has to ensure that all the pollution norms/Forest Rules as applicable in the State of Orissa during loading and transportation are followed. For any violation of pollution norms/Forest Rules by the party BSLC will not be held responsible on any account in this regard.

- The material has to be lifted within the period granted by DDM, Rourkela. No extension of time shall be given under any circumstance.

- BSLC reserve the right to cancel the whole or part delivery order, at any point of time during the tenure of contract, for which buyer shall have no claim of loss or damage for such cancellation.

Note: Buyer will have no claim on account of loss/reduction in indicative work.

8. **ACCEPTANCE OF OFFER / SALE OFFER / OFFER LETTER:**

When a bid is accepted by BSLC, the successful bidder (SB) shall be notified by an "Acceptance of offer / Sale offer / Offer Letter" which will either be dispatched by post / courier / fax / email or handed over to the authorized representative of the successful bidder.

9. **SAMPLING & ANALYSIS:**

Sampling will be conducted at the loading point by BSLC analysts and their analysis shall be final for payment and binding on both the parties. The cost of sampling & analysis shall be borne by the seller.

10. **WEIGHMENT:**

Weighment will be determined by weight volume ratio method by the BSLC Analyst, which shall be final and binding on both the parties.

11. **DELIVERY SCHEDULE:**

Successful bidders have to lift the total offered quantity within the specified period.

12. **ABANDONED GOODS:**

The Successful Bidder must have effect complete removal of the goods from the site within the date specified in the delivery orders issued by the BSLC. In case goods are not removed in full within the specified date, delivery orders for the left over quantity will be treated as cancelled. The goods so left over will be treated as abandoned goods at the risk and cost of the Successful Bidder. BSLC will have full right on such abandoned goods and will be entitled to dispose of the same in any manners it deemed fit without any reference to the Successful Bidder. The Successful Bidder will have no claim on goods treated as abandoned goods. The Successful Bidder shall further be held liable to compensate BSLC for all losses suffered by the BSLC, which would be recovered from the security deposit or any other sum to the Successful Bidder including material value.

13. **AWARDING AUTHORITY:**

Decision of BSLC Management shall be final and binding. BSLC reserves the right to accept/reject any bid without assigning any reason whatsoever.

14. **COUNTER OFFER:**

Any offer of the contractor which stipulates deviations from the terms & condition stipulated In chapter -I (terms and condition) and chapter -II (general condition) of the tender will be treated as counter offer and may be liable for rejection.

15. **MODIFICATION OF CONTRACT:**

No modification and alteration of the contract / agreement will be allowed during the currency of the contract. However difficulties, if any, experienced while implementing / execution of the contract, the same can be addressed with the approval of the CMD, BSLC.

18. **LEGAL & MISLANEOUS OBLIGATION:**

- 18.1. Depending upon the workload, the buyer (s) should assess the requirement of the workmen & equipment.
- 18.2. The buyer shall submit a list of workers / employees to be engaged by him.

- 18.3. The buyer shall report occurrence of all accidents in the Mines including particulars of his employees involved and effect payment of compensation as per the Workmen's Compensation Act, as amended from time to time within the prescribed time limit. In case of such accidents, the buyer must immediately bring it to the notice of the Mines Manager who will send necessary notice to the concerned authorities. In the event of buyer failure to pay / deposit with the Commissioner the amount of compensation payable under the Workmen's Compensation Act, the company shall have the right to receive the relevant amount from the buyer or other assets of the buyer with them for the settlement of the claims arising under the said Act and Rules at their own discretion and the buyer shall bear the full responsibilities in this behalf.
- 18.4. The buyer shall comply with all provisions laid down in the Industrial Dispute Act in matters relating to the settlement of various disputes arising in the work allotted to him and shall abide by the provisions of the said Act and Rules framed there under as amended from time to time by the Central Government in the matter of retrenchment, lay off and conditions of service of the employees engaged in his work. Besides he shall adopt all measures in the direction of maintenance of perfect industrial peace in the works allotted to him. Any failure in this respect shall be treated as disqualification of the buyer and the management shall be free to take appropriate action against the buyer including termination of contract.
- 18.5. The buyer shall make his own standing order for the labourers engaged by him and get the same approved through the concerned Regional Labour Commissioner or other appropriate authorities and implement the same in conformity with the provision of Industries Employment Standing Order Act. In absence of such standing orders, the model standing orders shall be implemented.
- 18.6. The buyer shall at his own cost, observe, perform and comply with the provisions of the contract labour Regulation and Abolition Act, 1971, and the rules made there under and as amended from time to time. The buyer shall have to observe, perform and discharge his/their obligations under the said Act and the company shall be entitled to recover from the buyer any cost of expenses that it may have to incur or suffer on account of contractors failure.
- 18.7. Copy of labour license issued by central Labour Authorities under the Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition )Act, 1971, as an evidence for similar jobs executed and having engaged labourers on raising/mining job earlier in Govt. company ,Public undertaking or in any organisation of repute. Necessary Labour license certificate for the tendered job ,if awarded is to be produced from the concerned authority and produced within the time specified in the L.O.I.
- 18.8. An attested copy of P.F registration certificate, within the time specified in the L.O.I.
- 18.9. Detailed list of Managerial & Supervisory personnel with name, age, qualification and experience including Directors in respect of company and Partners in respect of Firm to be submitted along with the tender papers.
- 18.10. The buyer shall abide by the decisions / recommendations/award of the Court / Labour Court / Industrial Tribunal / Wage Board or Commissions appointed by the appropriate Government in respect of this industry and shall ensure implementation of the provision of the decision / award / recommendation from time to time and maintain such relevant records and registers as are required to be maintained under those legislations/awards/decisions and produce them before the officers of the company and other statutory authorities as and when required. Any award for relevant industry shall be implemented if required within the rate decided in respect of this contract without any additional financial liability to the company.
- 18.11. The buyer shall be responsible to comply the provisions under the Mines Act 1952 Regulation and Rules framed there under in the matter of mining activities, health,

cleanliness, working hours, annual leave with wages etc. and various other provisions in the said Act in the works connected with the operation of mines. Any violation in this regard will be treated as Breach of Contract and necessary action shall be taken by the company as deemed fit ,including termination of the contract.

- 18.12. The buyer shall solely be responsible in respect of payment to the labourers under the payment of Bonus Act,1965.He shall also be solely responsible for maintenance of records in respect of the above payments and submission of returns in accordance with the provision of the said Act. The buyer shall have to submit all statutory records & returns etc. in respect of his work to the Mines Manager or any other authority as and when required for verification and such records are to be maintained as per the direction of Mines Manager.
- 18.13. In all matters connected with labour and staff under this agreement, the buyer shall be employer as defined in the various Acts. Rules, Regulations pertaining to the nature of work involved. The buyer shall have to obtain a license under section 12 of the contract labour (Regulation & Abolition) Central Rule,1971. No buyers to whom this act applies shall under take or execute any work through the contract labour accept under and in accordance with licence issued in that behalf by the licensing authorities. In the event of buyer failure to do so , the BSLC shall be free without prejudice to its others rights remade the breach and recovered the cost their of by making deduction from the buyers security deposit or otherwise.
- 18.14. In the event of the company sustaining any loss by reasons of any damage to any of its property which in the opinion of the company is due to the negligence or carelessness of the buyer or his employees the company shall be entitled to recover from the buyer (s) and the buyer will pay to the company the full amount for such loss. The amount of any such loss as certified in writing by the company or its agent is final and binding on the buyer.
- 18.15. The buyer shall report immediately to the company every case of epidemic/contagious disease occurring in the quarters occupied by his employees. Failure to do so will render the buyer liable to the company or any expenses or liabilities incurred by reason such failure.
- 18.16. The buyer shall report immediately non compliance of the provisions of Forest Conservation Act and Rules made there under. Any penalty damage etc imposed shall be borne by the buyer and will be recovered from the buyer dues or otherwise.
- 18.17. The buyer shall at his own cost, observe perform and comply with the provisions of all statutory enactments, rules, regulations and bye-laws framed there under as are applicable or made applicable for control/operation/regulation of mines during the execution of work and shall maintain such registers, documents, records etc. as are required under the various statutes , for production of the same before the Employer and/or other statutory authorities prescribed in this behalf, as and when required. Non compliance of the provisions/stipulations of these Acts/Rules will render the buyer liable to payment of necessary compensation/penalty, as deemed fit by the Employer. It will be the sole responsibility of the buyer to ensure all kinds of statutory payment to his workers and submission of return etc. to various statutory authorities in time. In case of buyer's default in making statutory payment in time, the Employer reserves the right to deduct necessary amount from the agencies towards such payments.
- 18.18. The buyer shall ply trucks and / or dumpers for transportation of Minor minerals. He shall provide licensed drivers and authorised helpers for the trucks and dumpers. Loading into trucks and dumpers will be arranged by the buyer. For this operation, the buyer must arrange adequate fleet or truck / dumpers.

- 18.19. All vehicles engaged for this work must be duly registered and fully insured against third party risks and must have fitness certificate, Road permit, Tax token etc. issued by road transport authorities of Orissa as required. The buyer shall be liable for all compensation that may arise for any accident, death, injury occasioned by or during the operation of the job.
- 18.20. The buyer shall declare holidays for the workers as notified by the Mines Act, 1952.
- 18.21. In the event of buyer's failure to pay his workmen at full rate to cover minimum earnings, the company shall arrange to disburse the same to his workmen and recover it from buyer security deposit of otherwise. The buyer shall maintain records for admissibility and/or payment of leave with wages, provident fund, maternity benefit, sick wages, paid holidays etc. No tools and implements for the work shall be supplied by the company.
- 18.22. No part of the contract shall be sublet without written permission of the Business Head of the company or transfer is made by Power of Attorney authorising others to receive payment on the buyer's behalf.
- 18.23. With regard to execution of this work, the buyer shall abide by the direction of Manager[Mines].

19. **ARBITRATION:**

Any dispute or difference under or arising out of or to in respect of the Tender Document may be referred to the sole arbitration of a person appointed by The Chairman cum Managing Director, The B.S.L.C. Limited, AG-104, 2<sup>ND</sup> FLOOR, SOURAV ABASAN, SECTOR –II Salt Lake City, Kolkata- 700091 and his decision in the matter will be final and binding on the Buyer and the Company. The arbitration will be carried out as per Arbitration Act, 1996 and Rules made there-under as amended from time to time.

Note:

- i) The Court of Sundargarh & High Court at Cuttack will have the jurisdiction to address any unsettled dispute.
- ii) No claim of arbitration will be entertained in regard to facts which party is supposed to ascertain before participating in the tender.

20. **JURISDICTION:**

All kinds of Legal proceedings against "The Bisra Stone Lime Company Limited" in any matter arising out of the sale of material shall be under the jurisdiction of appropriate Court of Rourkela.
