1) **Jaw Crusher** :(for Grinding of Iron & Manganese ore lump samples suitable for WD-XRF analysis.) Provision for dust extraction system should be with the jaw crusher.

Requirement for Jaw Crusher:-

- a) Crushing feed iron ore / manganese ore of size upto 150 mm
- b) Output size – less than 1 mm
- c) Metallurgical quality of Jaw - Mn. Steel, Hardened chrome steel, stainless steel, lined Tungsten Carbide (suitable for crushing of iron ore, manganese ore Samples with maximum specific gravity 2.5 t/m³)
- d) Mounting - Floor mounting type
- e) Material of construction of side support wall - Hardened and Tempered steel.
- f) Main motor drive - Suitable 3-phase motor with starter
- g) Crushing Capacity - 150-200 Kg per Hr.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENQUIRY

1. Sealed Tender in prescribed format provided in the Tender Schedule are invited from reputed, experienced manufacturer/auth. Dealer for supply, installation & commissioning of 01 sets of sample preparation equipments (Jaw Crusher, Vibratory Cup Mill & Hydraulic Press) for grinding, pulverizing & palletizing of Iron & Manganese Ore Samples suitable for WD-XRF analysis as per detail specification mentioned in Annexure – I. The prescribed tender documents can be obtained from the Manager (Finance), Thakurani on payment of Rs. 1,040.00 only in shape of Cash on any working day on or before 29.08.2011 by 12.00 Noon. or can be downloaded from our website www.birdgroup.gov.in, which shall be deposited along with a demand draft for Rs.1, 040.00 drawn on any nationalized bank in favour of “The Orissa Minerals Development Company Limited” payable at Barbil.

The sealed Tender should reach the office of The Manager (Finance) on or before 29.08.2011 by 3.00 P.M.

The Tender Document in respect of all the tenders shall be submitted in two parts i.e. Part – I – Techno Commercial Bid, Part – II – Price Bid in separate sealed envelopes. For two bid tenders both techno commercial bid & price bid shall be sealed in separate sealed envelopes with complete tender details super scribing on both envelopes and clearly identifying the techno commercial bid and price bid on the respective envelopes. Both the bids shall be kept in another envelope super scribing the tender no. and date.

The Part – I i.e. Techno Commercial Bid shall be opened at the office of Manager (Finance) at Thakurani, Barbil in presence of the Tenderers or their accredited representatives at 3.30 P.M. on dated 29.08.2011.

The date of opening of the Price Bid will be intimated in due course of time only to those tenderers who have qualified in the Techno Commercial Bids.

Qualification of the tenders shall be judged by the Techno Commercial Bids i.e. Part-I of the tender. In this respect the decision of the Company shall be final and binding on the tenderers

The Company shall not be liable for any delay in submission of the tender documents due to postal delay and no extension of date for tender submission/tender opening shall be given for this reason.

The Company also reserves the right to accept /reject any or the entire tender without assigning any reason thereof and also dose not bind him to accept the lowest bid.

The expected date of commencement work will be 15 days from the date of issue of LOI / agreement.

At any time prior to dead line for submission of tender, the purchaser may, for any reason whether at its own initiative or in response to clarification required by the prospective tenderer, modify the tender document by amendment.

2. **SCOPE OF SUPPLY.**

The tenderer is to include the detailed specification, schedule of delivery and commissioning of the equipments as per annexure-I. The tenderer must commit to accept of 3 (three) years warranty period for the equipments.

The tenderer shall carefully study the tender documents and shall satisfy him-self of the suitability, and shall take full responsibility for the efficient operation and guarantee of specified performance parameters of the equipments offered.

The tenderer shall inspect the site and shall satisfy him-self of the site conditions and shall collect any other information, which he may require before submitting the tender. Claims and objections due to ignorance of the site conditions will not be considered after submission of the tender.

The offer shall be for supply, installation and commissioning of specified equipments according to tender specification given in Annexure-I

The tenderer shall also furnish an item wise list of spare parts and consumables separately for 3(three) years of Warranty period for normal working of equipments. The operation, maintenance and spare part manuals are also to be made available with the equipments. The tenderer will supply catalogues, manuals of the equipments to facilitate after sales maintenance work.

The tenderer shall include in its scope of supply a set of special tools and tackles for repair, erection, commissioning and supervision of maintenance of the equipments.

3. **SCOPE OF INSTALLATION & COMMISSIONING.**

The installation & commissioning of the equipments shall be done by the successful tenderer and shall inter-alia include testing and providing the guaranteed contract performance certificate of the equipments. The equipments will be installed & commissioned within 15 (Fifteen) days from the date of delivery.

Commissioning of the equipment to the satisfaction of OMDC will be sole responsibility of the successful tenderer. The tenderer shall provide competent commissioning engineers to ensure the same.

The equipments shall be deemed to be commissioned only after successful full load testing and trouble-free run of 15 (Fifteen) days .

4. **TIME SCHEDULE FOR DELIVERY & COMMISSIONING.**

Delivery should be within 3 (Three) months to site and installation & commissioning shall be done within 15 (Fifteen) days from the date of delivery.

The mutually agreed period will become a firm contractual commitment from the time of awarding the contract. The successful tenderer shall be responsible for

coordinated delivery of the equipments and shall ensure delivery of the whole equipments as required at site for installation & commissioning.

5. **EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT & SECURITY DEPOSIT.**

- (a) The tenderer has to submit a sum of **Rs.40,000/-**(Rupees forty thousand only) in shape of Demand Draft drawn in favour of “THE ORISSA MINERALS DEVELOPMENT COMPANY LIMITED” payable on any Nationalized bank payable at Barbil. The EMD of unsuccessful bidder shall be refunded after award of the contract. The EMD of successful bidder shall be converted into Security Deposit (Interest Free).

If the tender will be cancelled by the purchaser (OMDC) for the cause what so ever, the EMD paid along with the tender will be refunded.

All bidders are requested to submit their option for refund of EMD i.e. either in shape of DD or through online Banking. The agency should submit details of account status as per the statement enclosed in “Annexure – V”, if opted for online/Electronic Fund transfer for refund of EMD.

- (b) The successful bidders will be required to submit security deposited equivalent to 5% (five percent) of the total value of the order (i.e basic + all duties, taxes, freight, insurance charges and erection and commissioning etc.) before the agreement.

N.B: The earnest money deposited alongwith the tender will be adjusted against security deposit and balance money will require to be deposited.

The security deposit (interest free) will be refunded after successful completion of order and warranty obligation, failing which the said security deposit shall be forfeited.

Tenders not accompanied with “EMD” are liable for rejection.

6. **QUALIFICATION CRITERIA.**

This invitation of Tender is opened to all leading Indian Manufacturers of their authorized Indian Distributor/Agents for the supply of the equipments as mentioned in the documents.

Copies of valid Sales Tax/ VAT Registration Certificate, details of PAN, Sales Tax Registration Number, Sales Tax Clearance Certificate, Proof of manufacturing Unit/Dealership, Manufacturers authorization form and two supply orders of similar type of equipment preferably to Govt. mining organizations for preparation of samples suitable for WD-XRF analysis.

7. **TRANSPORTATION.**

The successful tenderer shall deliver the equipments at OMDC Central Stores. Subsequent transportation and handling right from stage of drawing from stores and taking to site including assembly, installation and commissioning would also be the responsibility of the successful tenderer.

8. BASIS OF ORDER PLACEMENT.

The landed cost of the equipments as per technical specification as per “annexure-I” on FOR Destination basis.

The lowest quoted price for each item of this tender shall be treated as L₁ of that particular item and order shall be placed accordingly.

9. STATUTORY VARIATION.

The ex – factory price of the equipment shall be firm. The various taxes, duties and levies included in the offer should be shown separately. However, during the currency of contract, if any fresh taxes, duties or levies have been imposed on supply of equipments, such variation in the tax, duty or levy, if payable by purchaser, shall be paid by OMDC. For this purpose the successful tenderer shall provide necessary documentary evidence for tax arising out of variation shall be restricted to the contract and cannot extend to the sub-contracted supply received by the contractor. Increase in taxes, duties and levies beyond stipulated delivery period will be borne by the successful tenderer.

10. WARRANTY.

The tenderer shall provide warranty for a period of at least 3(three) years for all equipments from the date of commissioning.

The successful tenderer shall guarantee against defect arising out of workmanship, design, materials and performance to ensure satisfactory performance requirements indicated in the tender document. In the event of any inadequacy / defect / error / fault resulting in a fall in the performance of the equipments, the successful tenderer shall, rectify the same, including supply of spares at free of cost.

If the equipment is found defective during this warranty period, then the tenderer will supply necessary spares / components and will have to be repaired the equipments with free of cost at our site. For that the to and fro expanses will be borne by the tenderer.

The successful tenderer shall be responsible for the performance of the equipments supplied including any non-OEM component / assembly. If any breakdown of equipment is suspected due to any defect in a non-OEM component / assembly, it shall be the sole responsibility of the successful tenderer to rectify the defect and restore the same to operation.

All such replacement of defective parts mentioned above shall be made free of cost at site by the Supplier and the return of the defective parts to supplier’s works shall be Supplier’s responsibility and shall be made at his expense.

During warranty period, if any problem arises in machine and other accessories, it must be rectified within 2-3 days from the time of intimation through telephone message / fax / mail and our daily routine work should not be hampered.

Bidder should confirm minimum 2-3 days time period in which they can supply the spares/accessories at our site in the event of the break down of Equipment for which they have submitted tender during warranty.

11. SIGNING OF AGREEMENT & EXECUTION OF WORK.

The successful bidder is expected to appear in the office of AGM [I/C] to sign the contract agreement within five days and start the work from 15days from the date of issuance of LOI. In case the tenderer is decline to sign the agreement or to take up the work within stipulated time, in such eventuality will have no claim on the contract.

In case the tenderer declines to take up the work, OMDC reserves the right to terminate the contract and forfeit the earnest money deposits / security deposits of the tenderer in such eventuality , the tenderer have no claim for cost he/they might have incurred for taking the work and the cost of the work he / they have done by that time and the work may be rescinded.

12. USERS LIST.

The list of users especially for the same model / make of the quoted equipment with complete name, address and contact numbers of the user organization/ persons to be submitted for the last 3(three) financial years preceding the year 2011-2012 (to be submitted letter head of the bidders), along with the offer.

Detailed list of quoted model supplied to mining industries (preferably govt./ PSU organization) for iron / manganese ore sample preparation suitable for WD-XRF analysis along with performance certificate to be submitted during last 3 (three) financial years preceding the year 2011-2012, with the offer.

13. REASONABILITY OF PRICES.

The bidder should quote best minimum prices applicable for a premier Government Organization leaving no scope for any further negotiations on prices.

The bidder should give a certificate to the effect that the quoted prices are the minimum and they have not quoted the same item on lesser rates than those being offered to OMDC to any other customer nor they will do so till the validity of offer or execution of the purchase order, which ever is later.

The party must give details of the quoted equipments, if any, supplied to any Central Government Research Laboratory (India) during the last 3 (three) years along with the final price paid and performance certificate from them.

14. SPARE PARTS.

Availability of spare parts of the equipment/instrument must be guaranteed for a period of at least ten years from the date of supply. Supplier should be given an undertaking that the spare parts will be supplied within the specified period as and when ordered after warranty. Price list of spares and consumables should be submitted with Techno- Commercial Bid. The spare parts shall be on delivery basis at our Stores & Purchase Dept.

15. AFTER SALES SERVICES.

It should be clearly mentioned in the quotation whether the after sales services during and after the completion of warranty shall be provided directly by the supplier or their authorized agent/ representative. Terms of the after sales services, if any, may be mentioned in the offer. However, in both the cases, the original supplier shall be responsible for poor performance/services.

a) Bidder to submit details of after-sale-services for:

i) Equipment (for which bidder has been submitted by them) failed under warranty and in the event it is not under warranty.

ii) Spares/Accessories support for Equipment (for which bidder has been submitted by them) during warranty period & during out of warranty period.

(b) If supplier will provide service, than:

(i) Details of Service Centre,with name and address and name of the service engineers must be mentioned.

(ii) Proof of warranty agreement between the supplier and the successful provider. (if any).(if service will be provided other than supplier.)

16. ANNUAL MAINTENANCE CHARGES .

"The bidder must conform and accept the Comprehensive AMC of the Machine, which we may opt for maintenance contract after expiry of the warranty period.

The bidder should give full details of their different type of AMC of quoted model of equipment (WD-XRF).

The bidder should mention the name of Govt. Dept./PSU/Customers to whom they are providing AMC for such type of machine with documentary evidence to be enclosed along with Techno- Commercial Bid".

17. PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE.

All the successful bidders will have to submit the Performance Bank Guarantee for 10% of total value of order (i.e. final landed price).This guarantee shall be valid till 60 days after expiry of warranty period from the date of installation and commissioning. The PBG format shall be provided to the successful bidder later on along with the purchase order.

18. TERMS OF PAYMENT FOR EQUIPMENT.

90% payment will be made only after satisfactory supply, installation, commissioning of the equipment at site of the OMDC and after certification by our technical committee.

The balance 10% of the total order value shall be paid on submission of performance bank gurantee of equivalent amount. This Performance Bank guarantee shall be valid till 60 days after expiry of warranty period from the date of installation and commissioning. The PBG format shall be provided to the successful bidder later on along with the purchase order.

19. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES FOR LATE DELIVERY & LATE INSTALLATION.

In case the Supplier defaults in delivery and the Supplier has not explained the position to the Purchaser well in time and the Purchaser has not accepted an extension of delivery period, the Purchaser may at his option deduct from the Supplier's bill a sum @ ½% (half percent) of the price of any material which the successful tenderer has not been able to supply within the delivery schedule for each week or part of a week during which the delivery of such material may be in arrears subject to a ceiling limit of 10% by way of agreed liquidated damages and not as penalty provided the delay was not due to any force Majeure.

The same deduction rate i.e @ 0.5% per week will be imposed for late installation of the equipment at OMDC's site subject to maximum of 10%.

20. PENALTY.

In the event of placement of order to the successful tenderer, who fails to deliver the goods, the Company (OMDC) may at its discretion impose any of the following penalties:

(a) Cancellation of the purchase order in part or whole;

(b) Forfeiture or adjustment of earnest money or security deposit or PBG wholly or partly without notice to the Supplier;

Disqualify the bidder for participation in the tender for similar work of Company.

21. ARBITRATION.

Any dispute or difference arising in respect of the order/agreement/contract shall be referred to the Managing Director of the Orissa Minerals Development Company Limited (OMDC), AG-104, Sourav Abasan, 2nd Floor, Sector – II, Salt lake city, Kolkata – 700091 or his authorized representative as the Sole Arbitrator and the decision of the Sole Arbitrator on the matter in dispute shall be final and binding on the supplier/contractor/bidder/tenderer and the company. The arbitration shall be carried out as per the arbitration act and rules made there under as amended from time to time.

22. ERECTION AND COMMISSIONING.

To be carried out by the successful tenderer within 15 (Fifteen) days from the date of receipt of equipments at site. OMDC shall give intimation towards receipt of materials at site on the date of receipt of equipment.

23. TAXES.

The successful tenderer shall pay all taxes, duties, charges or levies that may be assessed or imposed on them by the Government of India. The tenderer shall clearly furnish the details of the taxes and duties presently payable.

Under the Income Tax Act, any Company responsible for paying any sum to any non-resident company shall deduct Income Tax at source. Accordingly, non-resident companies must produce a certificate from the concerned Income Tax authority in India indicating the rate of recovery of Income Tax at source for all payments due to them to cover liability, if any, under the Indian Income Tax Act, failing which payments shall not be released to the non-resident Company.

24. MODIFICATION OF CONTRACT.

No modification and alteration of the contract/agreement is allowed during the continuation of the contract. However difficulties, if any, experienced while implementing / execution of the contract, the same can be addressed with the approval of the MD, OMDC.

25. FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE.

Time being the most important feature of the contract if either party is prevented from the performance of its obligations in whole or in part for reasons of force majeure viz acts of God, acts of Government, acts of public enemy, war, hostility, civil commotion, sabotages, fire, floods, explosions, epidemics, lawful strikes, lockouts or statutory action or any cause of whatever nature or description beyond the control then provide notice of happenings of any such eventuality is given by the affected party to the other party within 15 days from the date of occurrence and cessation of the force majeure the period of force majeure shall be excluded from the time specified for fulfilment of obligations of the party prevented by force majeure.

If any of the events specified in this clause lasts for a continuous period of less than 7 days, such events shall not be construed to be force majeure events. Neither part can claim any compensation from the other party because of force majeure events.

26. DISPUTE SETTLEMENT.

In case of any dispute of differences arising out of this contract, the decision of Managing Director of OMDC shall be final and binding on both the parties.

27. LEGAL CAPACITY.

The tenderer shall satisfy OMDC that he is competent and authorized to submit tender and / or to enter into a legally binding contract with OMDC. To this effect, any person signing the tender shall render relevant documentary evidence, like Power of Attorney, that his signature on the tender submitted by him is legally binding upon himself and the supplier.

A person signing the tender or any document forming part of the contract on behalf of another shall be deemed to warrant that he has authority to bind such other and if it is discovered that at any time that the person so signing had no authority to do so, OMDC may without prejudice to other civil and criminal remedies, cancel the contract and hold the signatory liable for all cost and damages.

28. TENDER.

The tender shall comprise of 2 (two) parts :

- Part 1 - Techno-commercial Bid
- Part 2 - Price Bid

In order to qualify in Techno commercial bid of the tender, the tenderer must submit the following documents along with Techno commercial Bid.

- ▶ List of tests conducted at successful tenderer's premises and at site in presence of OMDC Engineer in charge.
- ▶ Manuals for specification, operation, maintenance and spares parts shall be submitted (2 sets of each equipment).
- ▶ Exceptions, if any, to any part of the tender document.
- ▶ Warranty for a period of at least three years for all equipments from the date of commissioning.
- ▶ All details (not related to the price bid) as detailed in the tender documents.
- ▶ Schedule for change of Spare Parts / Assemblies / Sub- Assemblies and Consumables during the warranty period and its guaranteed life.
- ▶ Performance Certificate of such capacity equipments supplied by the tenderer to other mining organization for sample preparation suitable for WD-XRF Analysis during the last 3 years proceeding the year 2011-12).
