- ii) The Agency should have NABL (National Accreditation Board of Testing and Calibration Laboratory) accreditation.
- iii) The Agency must have well equipped analytical Laboratory with required support of manpower at Barbil region.
- iv) Experience in the name of the partners of the firm or that of Director of the company will be considered as experience of the firm/company participating in the tender.

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## CHAPTER –III GENERAL CONDITION

### 1. DEFINITION:

- a. **Tenderer / Bidder :** Tenderer / Bidder means a person, Society, Firm or Company willing to participate by accepting terms and conditions given in the tender documents.
- b. **Tender:** Tender means the work to be performed according to the tender documents (both technical and /price bid) submitted by the tenderer for consideration of OMDC.
- c. **Name of the Tender:** Name of the tender means the work to be performed by the tenderer.
- d. **Techno- Bid:** Techno- Bid means documents regarding eligibility condition as stipulated in the tender documents for qualifying the bidder for consideration of the Price bid.
- e. **Rate:** Rate means the rate quoted by the tenderer in prescribed format for various activities to be performed by the agency.
- f. **Price Bid :** Price Bid means document containing the rate to be considered for the purpose of evaluation and award of contract.
- g. **Agency:** Agency means a person of society, firm, company whose tender has been accepted by the OMDC.

- i. **Competent Authority :** Competent Authority means MD or any designated officer by the MD
- j. **Taxes:** Taxes means Income Tax, Surcharge, Service Tax, Value Added Tax, Cess Tax, Entry Tax and any other tax, levy, fees, cess imposed by the government from time to time.

### 2. **EARNEST MONEY:**

- a) Earnest money i.e Rs.12,000/-(Rupees twelve thousand only) shall be accompanied inform of Bnk Draft/Pay Order from any schedule/Nationalized Bank.

### 5. OPENING OF TENDER :-

The technical bid part-I shall be opened on 30.09.2011 at 3.30 PM at the Office of the Manager (Finance), The Orissa Minerals Development Company Limited, Thakurani near Barbil, Dist-Keonjhar-\*(Orissa) in the presence of the tenderers or their accredited representatives. The date of opening of price bid shall be intimated to the tenderers those whose techno- bids found acceptable.

## 6. EVALUATION OF THE BIDS:

- (i) The Part-I Techno bid: Parties who will fulfill all requisite conditions of eligibility clause of Chapter-II of this document, will be construed as technically qualified and may be considered for Part-II Price Bid.
- (ii) The Price Bid of Technically qualified bidders shall be treated as L-1, if the rate quoted by such bidder for Part-II Price bid specified in each item as mentioned in description of work is the lowest among all the technically qualified bidders.
  - Item wise price should be quoted for each component of work
  - The agency will be selected based on L-1 basis for each item.

## 7. PENALTY :

If the agency fails to submit the analysis & assessment report within one month from the issue of job order then the penalty @5 paisa per ton per day will be levied on the basis of assessed quantity. If there is any deviation or dispute arises during supply to the agency shall be held responsible and the agency has to bear the loss caused to the company due to the deviation or dispute and same shall be recovered from the security deposit or any other dues of the agency.

## 8. AWARD OF CONTRACT :

The Company reserves the right not to accept or reject any or all tenders or distribute the work amongst different tenderers without assigning any reason thereof. Award of work shall be made at the absolute discretion of OMDCL. The company reserves the right to reject any part or whole of the tender without assigning any reason whatsoever. For such cancellation the tenderer shall not be entitled to claim any cost, charges, expenses incidental to or incurred by him through or in connection with the preparation and submission without assigning any reason whatsoever. OMDCL also reserves the right not to accept the lowest offer and to divide the work to more than one party/parties. OMDCL shall not be liable for any delay in receipt of the tender document by the tenderers due to postal delay and no extension of time to the tender opening shall be given for this reason.

## 9. PAYMENT & SETTLEMENT OF BILLS:

- [i] For quantitative assessment and qualitative analysis of different stack of subgrade iron ore (by rail /road) the agency shall submit the bills in triplicate with enclosed certificate to the concerned surveyor, Quality Control Department & Manager Mines of the company who shall forward the same to A.G.M[Mines] of the company. The A.G.M[Mines] will recommend the same to finance department for consideration of payment
- [ii] Income tax and other statutory deductions as applicable shall be deducted from the bill and the same will be deposited with the Government authorities by O.M.D.C.L.

## 10. ESCALATION :

- (i) The rate quoted and accepted shall be firm and fixed and no escalation shall be allowed during the contract period or such extended period of contract.
- (ii) In case the tenderer declines to take up the work or fails to cope up with the progress of work, OMDCL reserves the right to
  - (a) terminate the contract
  - (b) forfeit the Earnest money Deposit.

- (c) In such an event the contractor shall be barred from participation in any tender of the company for a period of two years.

#### 11. SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

- [i] The public analyst should have well equipped laboratory and skilled manpower.
- [ii] No part of the contract shall be sublet without written permission of the Business Head of the company or transfer is made by Power of Attorney authorizing others to receive payment on the agency's behalf.
- [iii] With regard to execution of this work, the agency shall abide by the direction of Manager of concerned mines. The analysis of different constituents of different samples (as per company's requirement) will be guided by the Manager Q. C.
- [iv] It is the responsibility of the agency to collect the information related to work from the Manager(Mines).
- [v] The agency indemnifies the company in full for any risk/ thing to be done in connection with the above contract work which were to be done by the contractor which arises on account of his default and/or any un fulfillment of his obligations in respect of which all cost and expenses are to be incurred by the company and such cost and expenses including interest if any are recoverable from the agency.
- [vi] In the event of agency's failure to fulfill the contract terms for execution of work therein, and to have the contractual obligations carried out by alternative arrangement and consequential loss suffered thereby shall be borne by the contractor.
