(A) TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:

Each Tenderer must be accompanied with the non interest bearing pre-bid Earnest Money Deposit (as prescribed) of Rs 40,000(Rupees Fourty thousand only) in shape of Bank draft/Pay

order drawn on any Schedule/Nationalized Bank in favour of "The Orissa Minerals Development Company Limited." payable at Barbil. Name of the remitter shall be mentioned in the DD/PO. Tender without prescribed earnest money shall be rejected. The earnest money of the successful bidder shall be converted into security deposit which bears no interest.

Note: - Earnest money of the unsuccessful bidder will be refunded after award of the contract.

2. **SECURITY DEPOSIT (SD)**

The earnest money of successful bidders shall be converted into security deposit and the security deposit shall not bear any interest. Security deposit will be released on demand and on successfully commissioning of vehicle along with the commissioning certificate.

3. **REASONABILITY OF PRICES**

(a) Please quote best minimum prices applicable for a premier Government Organization leaving no scope for any further negotiations on prices.

(b) The bidder should give a certificate to the effect that the quoted prices are the minimum and they have not quoted the same item on lesser rates than those being offered to OMDC to any other customer nor they will do so till the validity of offer or execution of the purchase order, whichever is later.

(c) Copies of at least last two supply orders received from other Iron and Manganese Ore mines or details of last two supplies made to other Government organizations preferably in India for the same item/model may be submitted with the offer giving reasons of price difference of their supply order and those quoted to us, if any.

4. **PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF BIDS.**

(a) Bids shall remain valid for a minimum period of four months after the date of bid opening prescribed by the Purchaser. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the Purchaser as non responsive.

(b) In exceptional circumstances, the Purchaser may solicit the Bidder's consent to an extension of the period of validity. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing. The bid security provided under Clause-2 shall also be suitably extended. A bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting its bid security. A bidder granting the request will not be required nor permitted to modify the bid.

5. **PENALTY CLAUSE FOR LATE DELIVERY (LD)**

(a) Subject to operation of Force Majeure, time for delivery and acceptance is the essence of this contract. The supplier shall arrange to ship the ordered materials within the delivery period mentioned in the order unless extended with/without penalty.

(b) In case of delay in supply on part of the supplier, a penalty @ 0.5% per week of Order/CIF value will be charged for delayed period subject to maximum of 5%.

(c) If the delay in the shipment of the ordered materials attributable to the supplier exceeds agreed time period from the date of original agreed upon date of shipment and extended with/without penalty, the OMDC shall have the right to cancel the contract/purchase order and recover the liquidated damages from other dues of the party or by legal means. It will also affect the other/future business dealings with such supplier.

6. **PENALTY:**

Penalty @ Rs 500.00 for each day of delay beyond issued of order of 90 days shall be imposed and recovered from the bills of the tenderer up to a maximum amount of 5% of the order value. The delay noticed with proper reason which is beyond the control of the tenderer the penalty can be waived by competent authority, OMDC on receipt of request from tenderer and recommendation of mines office. The competent authority if convinced can extend the period of supply for such period

as found reasonable and thereafter may terminate the order. In case of termination of the order EMD shall be forfeited. However, the payment of the bill for the work already completed shall be made to the tenderer by OMDC after due examination and recommendation AGM (I/C)

7. PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE:

The Agency has to submit an irrecoverable Bank Guarantee in favor of “The Orissa Minerals Development Company Ltd.” for an amount of equivalent to 5% of total contract value having validity period of fifteen months from the date of issuance of LOI. The Bank Guarantee is to be submitted in the prescribed format at the time of signing of agreement. The OMDC have the absolute right to en-cash the said Bank Guarantee in the event of failure of the agency to discharge their contractual/statutory obligation & liabilities. However this does not absolve the agency from his statutory contractual liabilities or otherwise which may be found more than the amount of Bank Guarantee.

B. ELIGIBILITY CONDITION

In order to qualify in the techno commercial bid of the Tender, the Tenderer must produce the following documentary evidence with the techno-commercial bid.

- a) The bidders are required to submit proof of ownership in the name of the firm/company along with the Techno commercial bid.
- b) Payment of cost of Tender document i.e. Rs.520/- including VAT @ 4%.
- c) Experience certificates towards supply, installation, testing and commissioning of mobile medical van.
- d) Experience in the name of the partners of the firm or that of Director Of the company will be considered as experience of the firm/company participating in the Tender.
- e) Registered Partnership Deed in case of a Partnership firm.
- f) Memorandum & Articles of Associations in case of a Joint Stock Company.
- g) Copy of PAN as per Income Tax Act, Service Tax No.
- h) Photo Copy of the latest Income Tax Return Signed by a Chartered Accountant.
- i) An undertaking, in company /firm’s letter head is required regarding that the party was not debarred/blacklisted by any PSU and OMDC at any point of time.
- j) A declaration to be submitted that the bidder has carefully read all terms and conditions of the Tender document and he is fully satisfied and accepted all terms and condition of the Tender as per undertaking format attached as per (Annexure – I).

(Note: Submission of any forged document will attract legal action including rejection of Tender or cancellation of contract at the risk and cost of the contractor if awarded.)

C. SCOPE OF SUPPLY

The tenderer is to include the detailed specification, schedule of delivery, and commissioning of vehicle as per CHAPTER-II. The tenderer must commit to accept of 1-year warranty period for the vehicle.

The tenderer shall carefully study the tender documents and shall satisfy himself of the suitability of the vehicle, and shall take full responsibility for the efficient operation and guarantee of specified performance parameters of the vehicle offered.

The offer shall be for vehicle according to tender specification given in CHAPTER-I.

The tenderer shall also furnish an item wise list of spare parts and consumables excluding diesel, tyres and lubricants (complete with price) separately for one year of Warranty period for normal working of the vehicle. The operation, maintenance and spare part manuals and shop manuals are also to be made available with the vehicle. The tenderer will supply catalogues, manuals of the vehicle (engine, transmission and any other component) to facilitate after sales maintenance work.

The tenderer shall include in its scope of supply a set of special tools and tackles for repairing, handling of erection, commissioning and supervision of maintenance of the vehicle.

D. Scope of Assembly and Commissioning

The commissioning of the vehicle shall be done by the successful tenderer and shall include interalia testing and proving the guaranteed contract performance of the vehicle. The vehicle will be commissioned within 15 (Fifteen) days from date of delivery of vehicle.

The tenderer shall supply the required tool at the time of commissioning of the vehicle.

Commissioning of the vehicle to the satisfaction of OMDC will be sole responsibility of the successful tenderer. The tenderer shall provide competent commissioning engineers to ensure the same.

The vehicle shall be deemed to be commissioned only after successful full load testing and trouble-free run of 15 (Fifteen) days and Commissioning Certificate shall be issued immediately thereafter.

1. Time Schedule for Delivery

Delivery should be within 90 days to site from the date of issue of LOI.

2. Transportation

The successful tenderer shall deliver the vehicle at OMDC Central Workshop, Thakurani. Subsequent transportation and handling right from stage of drawing from stores and taking to site including assembly / erection and commissioning would also be the responsibility of the successful tenderer.

3. Basis of order placement

The landed cost of the vehicle e.g. (i) Mobile Medical Van as per technical specification of same as per CHAPTER-II,

(ii) Charges quoted for obtaining operative license of the Mobile Medical Van, to be delivered at OMDC, CENTRAL WORKSHOP, and THAKURANI on the basis of L-1 bidder.

4. Statutory Variation

The ex – factory price of the vehicle shall be firm. The various taxes, duties and levies included in the offer should be shown separately. However, during the period of contract, if any fresh taxes, duties or levies have been imposed on supply of vehicle, variation in the tax, duty or levy, if payable by purchaser, shall be paid by OMDC. For this purpose the successful tenderer shall provide necessary documentary evidence for tax arising out of variation shall be restricted to the contract and cannot extend to the sub-contracted supply received by the supplier. Increase in taxes, duties and levies beyond stipulated delivery period will be borne by the successful tenderer.

5. Warranty

Warranty period shall be 18 months from the date of delivery.

The successful tenderer shall guarantee against defect arising out of workmanship, design, materials and performance to ensure satisfactory performance requirements indicated in the tender document.

In the event of any inadequacy / defect / error / fault resulting in a fall in the performance of the vehicle, the successful tenderer shall rectify the same, including supply of spares, free of cost.

The successful tenderer shall be responsible for the performance of the vehicle supplied including non OEM components/assemblies. If any breakdown of the vehicle is occurred due to any defect of non OEM component / assembly, it shall be the sole responsibility of the successful tenderer to rectify the defect and restore the same to operation free of cost.

E. Terms of Payment

For Vehicle

90% of the total order value shall be paid against receipt and acceptance of vehicle at site.

The balance 10% of the total order value shall be paid on submission of Performance Bank Guarantee of equivalent amount valid for one year after 30 days from date of acceptance of vehicle at site as per the format of Performance Bank Guarantee enclosed in "ANNEXURE-II".
